

Spreading the Study Over a Longer Period

University College Prague (hereinafter referred to as "UCP"), based on Article 10, paragraph 5 of the Study and Examination Regulations of UCP registered by the Ministry of Education, Youth, and Sports, allows students to spread their studies over a period longer than the standard study plan of the relevant study program. If teaching is spread out, the maximum length of study set by the Study and Examination Regulations of UCP must not be exceeded in the bachelor's degree for five years, i.e., ten semesters, and in the master's degree for four years, i.e., eight semesters. This procedure is particularly suitable for international students in the first semesters of study. As part of the study schedule, international students fulfill the accredited study obligations and properly receive credits for completed subjects. At the same time, they can improve their knowledge of the Czech language.
